6. Spurs. Only one spur may be worn on each boot. The contact surface of spurs and all edges must be smooth and rounded made of metal or plastic. Hammer spurs, "impulse spurs" with round knobs, spurs with flat discs, and "dummy spurs" with no shank are permitted. Rowel spurs, with a notched or serrated disc are prohibited. Spurs with a rotating disc that is not notched or serrated are permitted.
